Dear Mr. Lambros:

The Director's Office received your recent correspondence regarding the seven justices of the Minnesota Supreme Court sitting as of August 6, 1993. Justice Page remains on the Court and this Office has no jurisdiction to consider complaints against judges. Justice Coyne is deceased.

With regard to the other former justices, Rule 8(a) of the Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, states that the Director "may make such investigation as the Director deems appropriate as to the conduct of any lawyer or lawyers." Your dissatisfaction with a 1993 decision of the Minnesota Supreme Court does not provide a basis for believing misconduct occurred. No investigation will be initiated and we will be taking no further action concerning your correspondence.
